BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE

Please briefly present the partner organisation.

"The Association of Olympic Committees of Portuguese-Speaking Countries (ACOLOP) was formally established on June 8, 2004, in Lisbon, with a mission to strengthen both sports and cultural connections among Portuguese-speaking nations. Presently, ACOLOP encompasses the Olympic Committees of Angola, Brazil, Cabo Verde, Guinea-Bissau, Macau (Chinese SAR), Mozambique, Portugal, São Tomé and Príncipe and Equatorial Guinea. ACOLOP actively engages in promoting sports participation, physical education, and Olympic values across the region. The organization encourages involvement in sports events and educational initiatives. With a clear vision centered on sporting excellence and sustainable development, ACOLOP strives to form strategic partnerships contributing to the continual growth of the Olympic movement in its member countries. Serving as an Olympic Umbrella Organization, its members span four continents, collectively reaching a population of approximately 250 million people. The Portuguese language, therefore, holds a significant position among the most spoken languages globally.

The primary motivation behind ACOLOP's establishment was to reinforce bonds between member nations and foster unity and cooperation through sports. In ACOLOP's 2022-2028 Strategic Vision, there is a focus on promoting the Lusophony Games and positioning sports as an enabler for Sustainable Development Goals mainly on the protection of the Seas and Blue Economy."

She also has key positions in the IOC as a Member of Future Host Commission for the Games of the Olympiad, a Member of Sport and Active Society Commission, a Member of Olympic



Education Commission, and a Member of Los Angeles 2028 Coordination Commission. She is one of the most respected sports leaders in Africa.
