



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

The **FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DU SPORT POUR TOUS** a registered not-for-profit organization in Rome, Italy whose legal seat is at Viale della Musica 14, 00144, Roma, Italy (hereinafter referred to as "FISPT").

and

The **ASSOCIATION OF OLYMPIC COMMITTEES OF PORTUGUESE OFFICIAL LANGUAGE**, an international non-profit association, headquartered in Lisbon / Portugal, with offices located at Avenida do Atlântico, No. 16, Edifício Panorâmico, 14th Floor, Office 8, Parque das Nações, 1990-019 Lisbon Portugal (hereinafter referred to as "ACOLOP").

1. Introduction to the Memorandum of Understanding

The MOU between ACOLOP and FISPT will support the sustainable growth of Sports for All Programs across the Olympic Movement in the Lusophony and will enable FISPT to contribute to ACOLOP's key strategic priorities.

The FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DU SPORT POUR TOUS ("FISPT") is the international sports federation responsible for world governance of Sports for All Programs. FISPT is a federation that currently has 120 member associations, which represent Sports for All Programs and their athletes in more than 54 countries. FISPT is an International Federation recognized by the International Olympic Committee (IOC).

The Association of Olympic Committees of Portuguese Official Language (ACOLOP) is the international organization, currently headquartered in Lisbon (Portugal), which unites the National Olympic Committees of Portuguese-speaking countries. It is also responsible for awarding and organizing the "Lusophony Games" and other international sports events aimed at promoting cooperation among its member countries.



Each of them a "Party and together the "Parties".

2. FISpT support to ACOLOP and its National Olympic Committee Members

FISpT will provide ACOLOP and its National Olympic Committee Members with the following areas of support:

- Extended global broadcast reach through FISpT media and international partner media outlets;
- Access to International Sports for All Programs Events promoted by FISpT.
- Access to new partnerships with International Organisations;
- Access to new global community programs that will benefit millions of people across the World; and
- Added resources to all Sports for All Programs Member Federations in the Lusophony.
- Training and development support Sports for All Programs during ACOLOP activities, such as the Lusophony Games and the ACOLOP's Webinar Series.
- Recognising ACOLOP as Associate Member free of charge

3. ACOLOP support to FISpT and its Members

ACOLOP and its National Olympic Committee Members will provide with the following areas of support to FISpT:

- Extended global broadcast reach through ACOLOP media and international partner media outlets;
- Support FISpT to recognise the proper National Members in each country where there is a NOC part of ACOLOP.

4. Events

Sports For All Programs will provide ACOLOP and its NOC members with the opportunity to host high profile international Sports for All Programs Events promoted by FISpT.



5. Communication

No Party will make any public disclosure or issue any media release pertaining to the existence or/and the terms of this MOU or/and the existence of the Parties' cooperation itself, unless mutually agreed upon.

6. Confidentiality

The Parties hereto shall at all times keep confidential (and ensure that their employees and agents keep confidential) the terms of this MOU and any confidential information that they may acquire in relation to the affairs of the other Party and shall not disclose or use such information except (a) with the consent of that other Party or (b) if such information has come into the public domain otherwise than by breach by that Party of this clause or (c) as required by law or other applicable regulations, or any competent court. The duties of the Parties in this clause shall survive the expiration or earlier termination of this MOU.

7. Responsibility

Except for breach of any confidentiality position here of, no party shall have any liability to any other party for any liabilities, losses, damages (whether special, incidental, or consequential), costs or expenses incurred by a Party should the negotiation among the Parties be terminated without reaching a mutual agreement.

8. Terms Limit

This MOU remains in force in-perpetuity with a review period once per year.

9. Relations between parties

This MOU does not constitute either Party to be agent of the other or create a joint venture or similar relationship between the Parties and no Party shall have the



power to obligate or bind the other Party in any manner whatsoever. The Parties hereto shall act in all respects as independent contractors.

10. Inapplicability conditions

If a provision of the present MOU is contrary to, prohibited by or considered invalid by virtue of some legislation or regulations, such provision shall be considered inapplicable, and excluded to the extent that it is contrary, prohibited, or invalid. The other provisions of the MOU shall not be considered invalid and shall retain their force and effect to the extent possible.

11. Declaration

This MOU is the final, complete, and exclusive agreement of the Parties with respect to the subject matters hereof and supersedes and merges all previous discussions, writings and understandings between the Parties with respect to such matters.

No modification of or amendment to this MOU, or any waiver of any rights under this MOU, will be effective unless in writing and signed by the party to be charged.

The parties hereto have agreed this Memorandum of Understanding and therefore make this declaration by signing the agreement between the ASSOCIATION OF OLYMPIC COMMITTEES OF PORTUGUESE OFFICIAL LANGUAGE & FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DU SPORT POUR TOUS.
